

The Seacoast Road Race Series is comprised of eight unique races. They have joined forces to promote running for sport, fun and fitness, and the beauty of running on the Seacoast.

A special feature of these races is that each one is a fundraiser for a local non-profit, so your race entry fees help each organization achieve its goals.

See for yourself...

The Children's Museum of New Hampshire's Annual 5K Road Race and Fun Run raises funds to help provide free access to the museum for families in challenging circumstances. Now in its 31st year, proceeds from this race support programs for children on the autism spectrum, in Head Start, discounts for families receiving food stamps and an Alzheimer's Café. Race day feels more like a festival than a fundraiser, featuring a fun course, a kid's Fun Run, prizes, giveaways, great food, face painting and more.

The Runner's Alley/Redhook Memorial 5K Road Race is a fun 5K that donates 100% of all proceeds to Krempels Center, a nonprofit day program supporting those with traumatic brain injury in Portsmouth, NH. Over the years the race has netted over \$500,000 for Krempels Center, enabling us to have a huge impact on the programs and services they are able to provide to their clients.

Each year, **Pro Portsmouth's Market Square Day 10K Road Race** kicks off the festival of the same name. Monies raised through the race assist in funding Pro Portsmouth's program of Downtown events held throughout the year. In addition to Market Square Day, Pro Portsmouth produces First Night, Children's Day and Summer in the Street; all are free to the public.

The Amidon Family Dentistry York Days 5K is a race sponsored by Amidon Family Dentistry and is administered by the Town of York Parks and Recreation Department. All proceeds support Parks and Recreation Department community youth programming.

Where does the time go? This year, **The Saunders at Rye Harbor 10K** will celebrate its 40th anniversary. The Saunders race supports the programs of the NHSPCA.

The Fox Point Sunset 5 Mile Road Race supports enrichment activities for the students of the Newington Public School. Through the Newington School Supporters, the race proceeds help fund annual Artist-in-Residence programs, technology, music, as well as support for the Destination Imagination teams and a yearly scholarship.

The Great Island 5K is involved a variety of causes on the Seacoast including: funding the Dr. Thomas W. Quinn Scholarships (\$4,000 per year) for graduating HS seniors, financial support of the Portsmouth Track and Cross Country Booster Club, the maintenance and expansion of the Great Island Common Playground and Great Island Skating Rink as well as support for the Maude H. Trefethen Elementary School and Rye JH track teams.

The Great Bay 5K is a fundraiser for the Great Bay National Estuarine Research Reserve and the Great Bay Discovery Center, located on the shores of Great Bay in Greenland. Financial support from the race assists efforts to improve the health of Great Bay, and funds programs and capital improvements at the Great Bay Discovery Center.
